Coach Insignia Cabernet represents the pinnacle of winemaking craft, comprised of the finest selected lots of Bordeaux varietals from the family's Napa Valley Estate. Located in the heart of the Calistoga AVA, these Estate vineyards are planted in well-drained alluvial, sedimentary soils alongside Simmons Canyon Creek, which flows west from the Calistoga Palisades to the Napa River.

WINERY TASTING NOTES

The 2005 Coach Insignia boasts deep garnet color with opulent aromas of black cherry, blackberries and candied violet. The palate is full, showing plum and cassis, accented by layer of espresso-like fine grain tannin. With time in the glass the wine continues to open, evolving to express further nuanced aromas of tobacco leaf and dark cacao powder. - Whitney Fisher, Winemaker
