



THE STORY

The Hidden Terrace Vineyard is a well-kept secret sequestered on a steep south-facing slope at the edge of our Mountain Estate, high above the Sonoma Valley floor. Farmed entirely by hand due to the severe incline, this small vineyard is composed of rare tufa (volcanic chalk) soil that produces Syrah of intense concentration and varietal distinction. Extremely low yields limit the availability of this wine to private collectors directly from the winery.

THE WINE

- 100% Syrah
- De-stemmed, double sorted
- Whole berry fermented in small open-top fermenters
- Barrel aged 17 months in French Oak barrels (30% new oak)
- Bottled unfined and unfiltered
- Alcohol by volume 14.5%
- Bottle date: May 2015
- 102 cases produced

TASTING NOTES The 2013 Syrah Hidden Terrace Vineyard is once again one of the most distinctive wines in the Fisher range. Black pepper, smoke, savory herbs, inky dark fruit and wild flowers all blossom effortlessly to fill out the wine's ample frame. There is something magical about this mountain estate and the Syrah has plenty to say.
