



THE STORY

The Mountain Estate Chardonnay vines grow on a steep, rocky, Northeast-facing slope at an average elevation of 1,300 feet, receiving early morning sun and minimal exposure to hot afternoon temperatures. Planted in 1999, this vineyard has proven ideal for the gradual ripening and maximum maturation of Dijon clone Chardonnay grapes.

THE WINE

- 100% Chardonnay
- Harvested September 2nd – 13th
- Whole cluster sorted, then pressed
- Juice cold settled for 24 hours and moved to barrel by gravity
- Fermented, then aged 18 months in French oak barrels (42% new)
- No sulfite additions at harvest or during aging
- Lees stirred twice monthly for 15 months
- Alcohol by volume 14.3%
- Bottle date: March 2017
- 660 cases produced

TASTING NOTES

Fisher's 2015 Chardonnay Mountain Estate Vineyard has turned out beautifully. Soft, silky and nuanced, the 2015 speaks to finesse above all else... Tangerine, lemon peel and expressive floral notes grace the polished, understated finish.
