



THE STORY

Commemorating Fred and Juelle's wedding in 1975, the Wedding Vineyard is not only an integral part of the winery, but of our family's life in the Mayacamas Mountains. First planted to Martha's Vineyard clone Cabernet in 1973, the Wedding Vineyard covers eleven gently sloping acres (up to 15 degrees, oriented southwest) on our Mountain Estate at an elevation of 1,200 feet. Approximately nine acres were replanted in 2001 under the careful guidance of David Abreu: seven blocks of Cabernet (clone 337 and Martha's Vineyard clone), one block of Petit Verdot (clone 400) and one block of Cabernet Franc (clone 327). The remaining original block of Wedding Vineyard was replanted in 2010 to Cabernet (Weimer clone).

THE WINE

- 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Cabernet Franc, 6% Petite Verdot
- Whole-berry fermented in small open-top fermenters
- Aged 19 months in 100% new French oak barrels
- Alcohol by volume 13.9%
- Bottled Date: June 2013
- Cases Produced: 247

REVIEWS Deep ruby. Tightly focused redcurrant and cherry aromas are complemented by a sexy floral quality and a hint of smoky minerals. Unfolds slowly on the palate, offering vibrant bitter cherry and spicecake flavors along with a sweetening note of vanilla. Finishes with excellent persistence, an echo of cherry and sneaky, firming tannins. (91 Points) ~ Stephen Tanzer's, *International Wine Cellar*

Another striking 2011 from Fisher. Firm yet beautifully integrated tannins provide the backbone for this expressive, nuanced wine. Violets, white pepper, blackberries and melted road tar are all very much alive on the striking, nuanced finish. The 2011 is a wine of significant potential.
